Sepura chose to support Arthur Rank in memory of David Armitstead, a colleague who sadly died in the care of the Hospice early in 2019.

Arthur Rank's Hospice at Home service enables patients to die peacefully and with dignity in their own home. Due to limited funding, each night the team is unable to provide care to one in three people referred to them, whose choice it is to remain at home. Arthur Rank Hospice launched the 'Help Us Be There' appeal in May 2019 in the hope of raising £100,000 which equates to 200 additional nights of care to meet this unmet need. Sepura's donation takes the current fundraising total above £90,000.
